Sport without rules is chaos. This is certainly true of Karting. One of the most important responsibilities of the VKA Board is reviewing, maintaining, and publishing Guidelines for safety and classification of Karts and their equipment. The **2019** *Guidelines* are a refinement of the guidelines that VKA has promulgated for many years. The *Guidelines*, which help establish consistency at all events, are posted on the VKA website: <u>www.VKAkarting.com</u>. For your convenience, the changes that have been made to each Class for 2019 are highlighted in this edition of *FIRSTURN*<sup>©</sup> on page three.

While the VKA strives to maintain a "period correct" approach to the sport, we need to be responsive to safety and economics. For this reason you will see an evolution of the Guidelines, reflective of the desires of the membership. At some events we have seen an increasing number of sidewinder karts, especially Yamaha-powered machines. Last year the *Guidelines* attempted to address this phenomenon and provide even more opportunities for expansion of the sport with **YAMAHA LIMITED**. This year refinements have also been made to accommodate other evolutions including an optional Classic Division for karts 30-years old and two optional classes for, 4-stroke engines.

Future editions of **2019 VKA** *FirsTurn*<sup>o</sup> will showcase our full-color magazine format including VKA event photos and reports, technical articles, stories of personal interest, and informative news. Non-members can get an idea of the richness of the publications by viewing an example on the VKA Website (<u>www.VKAkarting.com</u>).

The conduct of the events that you see associated with VKA is under the sole jurisdiction of the respective Promoter. While VKA does not sanction events, we support anyone interested in becoming a promoter through our **Promoter's Package**. It provides essential information for holding a vintage karting event using VKA Guidelines to help foster consistency between events. Promoters should be aware of one of the major 2014 VKA membership survey results: 99% want consistency between events! Before you consider adding a "promoter's option," consider the impact it will have on how participants will need to change their equipment for your event. Any changes should be announced well before the planned event date and should be part of the event flyer.

- CHANGE: 4-Cycle Stock Class to CLASS 20. 4-Cycle Stock; Modern tires (56 min. hardness)
- **CHANGE**: 4-Cycle Modified Class to **CLASS 21**. 4-Cycle Modified; Modern tires (56 min. hardness).
- CLASSES 17, 18 & 23: No carb triggers.
- ADD: CLASS 23 -Dual Yamaha S/W 100cc same as Class 16 except, 56 min. tire hardness; allowable tires in para. 6b; engine clutches only; 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" axle OK if original; karts mfg. prior to 1987; no carb triggers.
- No **Steel Nytro** clutches.

### Guide to 2019 Events

<u>**Tiers:</u>** VKA Events are classified as **Tier I** or **Tier II** Events. **Tier I** Events are "scored" events. **Tier II** Events are not scored/practice-only events.</u>

**Enduro**: If enough Enduro karts express interest in participating in a sprint event, promoters are encouraged to include them in appropriate classes. Static Kart Shows at both events are always a crowd pleaser.

**Northeast Promoter's Cup**: The 2019 Promoters' Cup Series consists of four events in the Eastern Region of VKA. Participants in certain classes are scored at each event. The participants with the best score at three of the four events are the event winners.

**Suggested Gearing**: The Event descriptions may make a suggestion for gearing indicated by an asterisk. Gearing suggestions are based on single American engine, under 6.1 c.i., Sidewinder.

**Discounts**: Promoters are encouraged to offer a discount to VKA Members. This will help promote not only VKA, but attendance at your event.

Events are listed by Region; West; South; Midwest; and Northeast (Promoter's cup and other). Within Region, Events are listed chronologically.
